Arctic Tern Cam Lock Strut Installation Guide

This guide provides step-by-step instructions for retrofitting existing Classic Struts with the new Cam Lock Struts.

What's Included

1 Pair of Cam Lock Struts

Tools Required

- Philips Screwdriver
- Snap Ring Pliers
- Small Piece of Cardboard

Installation Steps

Step 1: Remove the Existing Struts

a) Protect the Acrylic

a. Slide a small piece of cardboard between the lower strut bracket and the acrylic to protect the surface during removal.

b) Detach the Lower Strut Bracket

- a. Use snap ring pliers to insert the tips into the lower strut bracket.
- b. Spread the lower strut bracket by gently squeezing the pliers while gripping the bottom of the strut.
- c. Pull inward to pop the strut out of the lower strut bracket.

c) Remove the Top Strut Bracket

- a. Using a Philips screwdriver, remove the screw holding the top strut bracket by turning it counterclockwise.
- b. Retain the screw, as it will be reused for installing the new Cam Lock Struts.

Step 2: Install the Cam Lock Struts

a) Attach the Top Bracket

- a. Position the top bracket of the new Cam Lock Strut where the original bracket was removed.
- b. Reinstall the Philips screw, turning it clockwise to secure the top of the strut.

b) Attach the Lower Bracket

a. Open or release the cam latch on the new strut.

- b. Extend the strut so that the lower strut mount aligns with the lower bracket on the acrylic.
- c. Apply gentle pressure to pop the lower strut mount into the bracket.

c) Repeat on the Other Side

a. Complete the same steps on the opposite strut.

Step 3: Test the Cam Lock Mechanism

- a) Open the window fully.
- b) Release the cam latches and adjust the window to your desired position.
- c) Close the cam latches to secure the window in place.

Additional Tips

- Always work on one side at a time to maintain stability during the installation process.
- Ensure that all screws are securely tightened before testing the struts.
